Incase of more clarifications or problems with the same, they are requested to notify beforehand for alternative arrangements to be made.

Platform / Riser

A platform or riser on the stage and should have approximately the following dimensions:

15 ft length and 10 ft breadth and 1-2 ft height

(To accomodate 5-6 artistes on stage)

Platform Cover

A rug or carpet (should not be cushioned or spongy) covered by a plain white sheet to cover the entire surface of the platform/riser.


Greenroom Facilities

- A large carpet or equivalent to accommodate at least 8 artistes, along with their instruments.
- Two acoustic Tanpuras of Pitch D#.

Recording

- Prior permission of the artistes needs to be obtained for any form of recording / webcast / publishing excerpts or complete concert recordings on any public domain.
- In cases where permission is obtained, a copy of the digital recording of the performance is to be handed over to the artistes, post concert.

• For main vocals- Shure SM-58 / AKG D-7 with long boom stand and separate auxiliaries.

- For tabla Shure SM-57/58 with short boom stand and separate auxiliaries.
- For Harmonium- Shure SM-58 with long boom stand and separate auxiliaries.
- For Tanpura Shure SM-58 with long boom stand and separate auxiliaries.
- For electronic tanpura Shure SM 57/58 (no stand)
